Version / Characteristics

- Designed for cold beverages
- Cooling beverages with ice pipes
- Detachable ice pipes for filling with ice
- Drip trays: integrated, removable

Intended Use

Beverages dispenser is designed for cooling and keeping suitable beverages cool with the use of ice pipe.

Installation

1. Set the beverages dispenser on a flat, safe surface, which features load-bearing capacity sufficient for the weight of the appliance and is stable enough.
2. Avoid places of direct sunlight, for this could negatively impact cooling functionality.

Operation Instructions

1. Before the first use, thoroughly clean the beverages dispenser according to the instructions in section '**Cleaning**'.
2. Make sure that drain taps are closed, and containers and drip trays are correctly positioned on bases.

3. Insert ice pipes in containers. Make sure they are securely set in the containers' bottoms.
4. Place covers on containers. They additionally secure ice pipes from the top.
5. Use openings in covers to fill containers with pre-chilled beverages.
6. Fill ice pipes with ice-cubes.

7. Put lids on containers.

The ice in ice pipes keeps beverages chilled for long time.

Beverage Dispensing

1. Dispense beverages from containers as needed.
2. Place a suitable container under the selected drain tap (cup, glass, mug) with maximum height of 14 cm.
3. Press the drain tap down to dispense the beverage to a container.
4. When required amount of beverage is dispensed, release the drain tap.

The drain tap closes automatically.

Cleaning

WARNING!

For cleaning, do not use any scouring agents containing solvents nor corrosive cleaning agents. They may damage the surface.

1. Clean beverages dispenser after each use.
2. Remove lids and covers from containers; remove containers from bases; remove ice pipes from containers.
3. Empty containers and ice pipes.
4. Clean containers thoroughly with warm water, a soft cloth or a sponge and a mild cleaning agent. If needed, use plastic dish-washing brush.
5. Clean thoroughly drain taps, filling containers with hot water and draining it through drain taps.
6. Wash covers, lids and ice pipes thoroughly with warm water, a soft cloth or a sponge and a mild cleaning agent.
7. Wash removable drip trays and grates with warm water and a mild cleaning agent.
8. Thoroughly rinse the cleaned parts with fresh water.
9. Wipe bases with a damp, soft cloth.
10. Dry all surfaces with a linen-free cloth.
