Intended Use

The wine rack will hold up to 130 bottles in a lying position on 5 chrome steel bottle racks, thus saving space.

Thanks to a simple plug-in system, assembly literally takes a moment and the shelf rack unit is immediately ready for use.

Assembly

Corner Post Assembly



All four corner posts consist of two parts and are screwed together using threaded fasteners, which are already screwed to one of the two parts of a corner post.

The top part of the corner post has a plastic cover at the top, and the bottom part of the corner post has levelling feet at the bottom.

Manually twist the two parts of the corner post firmly in a clockwise direction.
 If the two parts of the corner post cannot be easily screwed together, check that the two threaded parts are properly assembled.

Rack Shelf Assembly

 First, assemble the lower rack shelf to the corner posts.

NOTE!

We recommend that this rack shelf be mounted no higher than 15 cm above the floor.

At the desired height, push the tapered plastic latches into the grooves of corner posts so that the small tapered end of the plastic snaps faces up and the thicker end faces down.



- 3. Slightly tilt the rack to the side.
- Slide the tops of the four corner posts (with plastic covers) through the corner holes in the bottom of the rack until they reach the plastic latches.



- 5. Align the rack.
- Firmly press the corners of the bottom of the rack from the top down to make sure it is firmly seated on the plastic latches.

Subsequent Assembly

- To get another shelf of the rack at the (next) desired height, attach 4 plastic latches to the corner posts.
- Slide the shelf from the top through the corner posts down to the plastic latches and press it firmly.

NOTE!

Using a rubber mallet can make assembly easier.

Repeat previous steps No. 1–2 to assemble subsequent shelves of the rack.



Now, the entire rack is assembled.

Positioning

- 1. Set the rack in its intended location.
- 2. To equalize the height (level) of the rack, screw or unscrew the feet in the lower parts of the corner posts.

Cleaning

ATTENTION!

For cleaning, do not use any scouring agents containing solvents nor corrosive cleaning agents. They can damage the chrome surface.

- 1. Clean the rack regularly with warm water and a soft, damp cloth. Use a mild cleaning agent when required.
- 2. Dry the shelf unit with a soft cloth.
